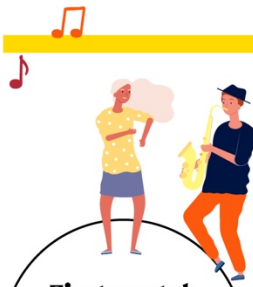

Bible Story

Jesus Forgives Peter
(John 21:1-19)

Bottom Line

Friends forgive one another.

Use this guide with your family to learn how God can help us be better friends.

Activity

True, False, Shoot!

What You Need

Laundry basket, balled-up socks, surprise treat

What You Do

Place the laundry basket in the center of the room. Direct your child to walk 10 paces directly away from it. Then explain the game: You'll ask the following questions. If they get a question wrong, you'll give them the correct answer and move on to the next question. If they get a question right, they get one point and a chance to try to toss a pair of socks into the basket. If they get the socks into the basket, they get an extra point (two points total). Keep track of your child's score as you go.

1. True or false: On the night Jesus was arrested, Peter told everyone that Jesus was his best friend. (*False; Peter said that he didn't even know Jesus.*)
2. True or false: After Jesus died and came back to life, Peter and his friends got on a boat to go fishing. (*True*)
3. After Peter and his friends fished all night, they caught: a) no fish, b) a few fish, or c) a ton of fish? (*a. no fish*)
4. True or false: After they were done fishing, they looked on the shore and saw Jesus standing there. (*True; but they didn't recognize who He was*)
5. What happened when the disciples threw their nets on the right side of the boat? (*The net was so full of fish that they couldn't get it into the boat!*)
6. What did Peter do when he realized it was Jesus on the shore? (*He put on his coat and jumped into the water.*)
7. When Peter and his friends got to the beach, what was Jesus doing? (*cooking breakfast*)
8. True or false: When Jesus told Peter to "feed my lambs," He meant that He had some pet lambs at home and He needed someone to take care of them. (*False; He meant that Peter should take care of the people following Jesus*)
9. Did Jesus forgive Peter for saying that he didn't know Jesus? (*Yes*)
10. Jesus told Peter, "Follow me." What do you think it means for us to follow Jesus today? (*To love others the way Jesus loves us; to forgive; to show kindness; to put others first*)

When the game is finished, surprise your kid with a treat!

Talk about the Bible Story

Was Peter a good friend to Jesus? (*Not all the time. He said three times that he didn't know Jesus.*)

Was Jesus a good friend to Peter? (*Yes. Jesus forgave Peter.*)

Has a friend ever hurt your feelings? How did that feel? What did you do?

Are there any friends in your life that you need to forgive right now? Tell me more. Let's pray together and ask God to help us forgive them. Remember, friends forgive one another.

Prayer

Use this prayer as a guide, either after talking about the Bible story or sometime before bed tonight:

"God, thank You for teaching us how to be a good friend. Jesus showed us that even though a friend may hurt our feelings, we don't have to stay hurt. We have the power to forgive. Because Jesus forgives us, we should forgive others. That's what good friends do. Thank You for forgiving us and loving us. Thank You for being the best Friend we could ever ask for. Amen."

Read Ecclesiastes 4:9-10

Oh, Peter!

Have you ever said something and it hurt someone's feelings? That's exactly what Peter did in our Bible story this week. He messed up over and over again and ended up hurting one of his best friends, Jesus. The cool part of the story, though, is that Jesus showed us exactly how a friend should respond. He went and found Peter and forgave Him. What would you have done if you were Jesus? Can you think of a time when someone forgave you when you did something that hurt them? Turn this page over and see how many times you can find the phrase FRIENDS FORGIVE. **Know that Jesus showed us how to forgive, even when we are hurt.**

Forgive And Forget

Ask an adult to help you look up Ephesians 4:32. This verse says to be kind one another and forgive one another. Why? Because Jesus forgave you! Can you think of a time when a friend hurt your feelings and you really didn't want to forgive them? Maybe they laughed at you or said something hurtful to you. It's really hard to forgive sometimes. The next time someone hurts you, forgive them and show them that you forgive them. Make them a friendship bracelet or paint a rock and tell them that their friendship rocks! **Look for ways to show your friends that you forgive them.**

3

Forgive or Explode!

Forgiving someone can be very hard! When we don't forgive someone, we bottle up all our anger inside until we want to explode! Let's do a little experiment to show you what I mean. Ask an adult to help you follow these instructions:

1. Add 1/4 cup warm water to a plastic zip-top sandwich bag.
2. Next add 1/2 cup of vinegar to the same bag.
3. Measure out 3 tsp. of baking soda and dump that in the center of a tissue.
4. Fold up the tissue around the baking soda.
5. Drop the tissue into the bag and close it.
6. Step back.

The explosion of the vinegar and the baking soda shows what it can feel like on the inside of us when we don't forgive others. **Ask God to help you forgive your friends when they have hurt you.**
