HCYM Sunday Teaching Series (August 20, 2017 – November 5, 2017)

Series: Propel (August 20 – September 17, 2017)

Series Description: How do we know we're moving forward in our faith? And what are the things that help us get there? The good news is that, like any good Father, God wants us to grow. He wants to see us move forward. So, He doesn't make it complicated. In fact, as we look at four things God uses to propel our faith, we may find that growing up spiritually can be simpler than we ever imagined.

August 20: Big Life...When it comes to our faith, doing is better than knowing.

August 27: Big Team...God uses people to propel our faith.

September 3: No HCYM (Labor Day)

September 10: Big Serve...There's a direct connection between growing and serving.

September 17: Big Moments...In tough times, God works in you so that He can work through you

Series: If/Then? (October 22 – November 5)

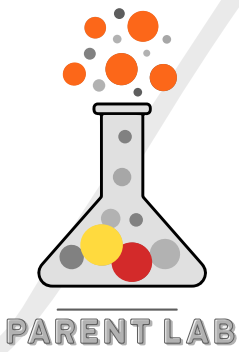
Series Description: How do you normally introduce yourself? Maybe you start with, "Hi. I'm (insert your name here)." But what comes after that? Sure, you can talk about where you go to school, or what hobbies you're into, but that doesn't really introduce anyone to you, just facts about you. When Jesus talked about Himself, He would make statements like, "I am the Good Shepherd" and, "I am the bread of life." As strange as they sound, these statements give us a better picture of who Jesus is. Because if He is a shepherd, then we are His sheep. And if He is the bread of life, then we can be satisfied in Him. In this series, we'll discover that the way Jesus described Himself, gives us a clue into who we are as well.

October 22: If He is Who He says, then I will follow His lead.

October 29: If Jesus is the Good Shepherd, then you are in good hands.

November 5: If Jesus is the bread of life, then you can be satisfied.
