### LIFELINES: A Series on Godly friendship DATES: AUGUST 25 – SEPTEMBER 22

**Description:** Do you have any friendships you can really count on — the kind of friendships you might call your "lifelines?" God designed us to have friendships we can trust, but God also knew we'd need some help figuring out how to build friendships that are lifelines for each other. In this 4-week series, HCYM will look at the kind of friendship Jesus models for us: friendship that lets us be real, gives us a chance to grow, gives us a group when we feel alone, and can even change the world.

#### MOSES: An in-depth series on the life of Moses. DATES: SEPTEMBER 29-NOVEMBER 10

**Description:** Each week will cover as different aspect of his story, from his early days as a "Prince of Egypt," to his struggles leading the complaining Israelites through the wilderness, all the way to Moses being told by God that he would not be allowed to enter the Promised Land and the book of Hebrews still calling Moses a man of faith.

## DROP IT: A series about dropping certain things in order to find true life in Jesus. DATES: NOVEMBER 17-DECEMBER 15

**Description:** "Drop It" is a three-week series that centers on the idea of HCYM students "dropping" certain things from their life in order to find the most satisfying life possible in a relationship with Jesus. It examines the life of three prominent New Testament figures who "dropped it" all to follow Jesus: Mary Magdalene, Peter, and Paul.

# GATHER: A morning of interactive worship and prayer DECEMBER 22

**Description:** A morning to pause from the busy schedules of school, life, and everything else and focus on Jesus.

### 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday of every Month - ALL TOGETHER NOW

As a youth ministry we want to do a much better job of helping our youth connect on a deeper level with the rest of the church. To help with this we are going to be worshipping together/sitting together in the Hillcrest sanctuary the first Sunday of every month. We are working on creative ways to involve and include our students and small group leaders in the service. This means we will not have a high school gathering in the Student Center on the first Sunday of every month. Also, we will be having a FREE breakfast for all high schoolers in the Fellowship Hall from 10:15-10:40am on those Sunday's so they can connect with their small group on a face-to-face level before heading upstairs for the service.
