

#### **DISCUSSION IDEAS:**


"How do you think the disciples felt when they saw Jesus being taken away? (Scared, sad, confused) The disciples thought that Jesus was going to become a king right away. They didn't know that God had a different plan—a plan that seemed upside down from what everyone thought was going to happen. And because they were sad and confused and scared, they missed a chance to put Jesus first. Instead, they ran away when Jesus needed them most.

"There might be times when you're sad or confused, too. Someone in your family may be really sick. Or something sad might happen. But even when you're sad or confused or scared, God can help you *[Bottom Line]* put others first. You can pray for others, you can give them a card, or you can make cookies for them.

[Make It Personal] (Tell kids a way that you've put others first. Explain how it helped the other person and how you felt afterward.)

"What are some ways that you can **[Bottom Line]** put others first? (I can share my candy, I can let my brother have the last cupcake, I can let my friend choose which game we play.) Great ideas! There are lots of ways that you can **[Bottom Line]** put others first!"
